With over 40,000 opportunities from more than 10,000 sponsors, SPIN is a consolidated source for easily locating external funding opportunities using a variety of the following features:

- Search/filter using keywords, sponsor, location, etc.
- Set up personalized automatic funding alerts and track opportunities of interest
- Receive notifications of new funding opportunities
- Access curated lists of WashU managed internal selections
